John Graham of Claverhouse, known as “Bonnie Dundee”, who dominated Scottish affairs in the later years of the 17th century. He was victor of the battle of Killiecrankie at which he fell, and was commemorated by the beautiful piobaireachd “The Lament for the Viscount of Dundee”
