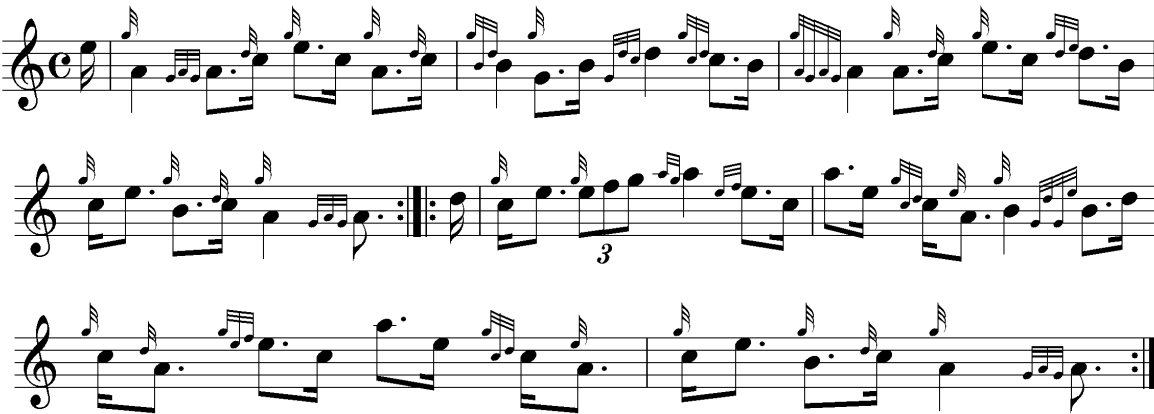


A Scottish Ramble
