Dougal Graham of Stirling (1721-1779)
was probably the best selling author in
18<sup>th</sup> century Scotland making a large part
of his living by writing and selling chapbooks.
He frequently used the pseudonym 'The Scots
Piper', and the piper logo for the present
collection is reproduced from one of his plates
